# Motiv8 Foundation Highlights

## AUGUST 2022

Continued our Back to School initiatives in Hawaii, Oregon and Atlanta, including distribution of school supplies and back packs. Through donations and memorabilia, we supported the St. Francis Healthcare Gala, the Boys and Girls Club Golf Tournament and After School All Star's Annual Fundraiser.



## DECEMBER 2022

For the NFL's My Cause My Cleats, Marcus represented the Shoes that Fit Charity. His cleats were designed by two students from King's Way High School in Vancouver Washington under the direction of Justin Tigner. Justin is a sports artist and high school art teacher that is famously known for his custom work.

## JANUARY 2023

The Motiv8 Foundation continues to support the Polynesian Hall of Fame in 2023. We provided support to the Unity Bowl with the AIGA Foundation, the Aloha Stadium Closing Ceremony and Project Vision's Vision to Learn Program.

## FEBRUARY 2023

Motiv8 sponsored the Hawaii High School Athletic Association (HHSAA) Boys and Girls State Soccer Tournament. Motiv8 and Marcus strive to provide athletic outlets for kids of all ages and especially in communities that helped shape his journey.



## JUNE 2023

On the same day, Marcus presented the first Motiv8 Resource Center in conjunction with Office Depot to the Boys and Girls Club of Honolulu. The Resource Center provides a place to complete their homework and have access to online resources. We continue to provide Resource Centers in Hawaii and Oregon.

## MAY 2022

Marcus and Kiyomi arrived in Atlanta in April of 2022 and immediately started to make a difference in the community. Motiv8 donated home furnishings for two families facing homelessness through the Atlanta Children's Shelter.



## JUNE 2022

Motiv8 Foundation was again the presenting sponsor for the GPA College Showcase which targets high school players who strive to play football at the college level. Coaches from various Division II and Division III colleges were in attendance. Motiv8 also provided 200 backpacks to the participants (girls and boys) of the Youth Impact Program (YIP) at UH Manoa.
